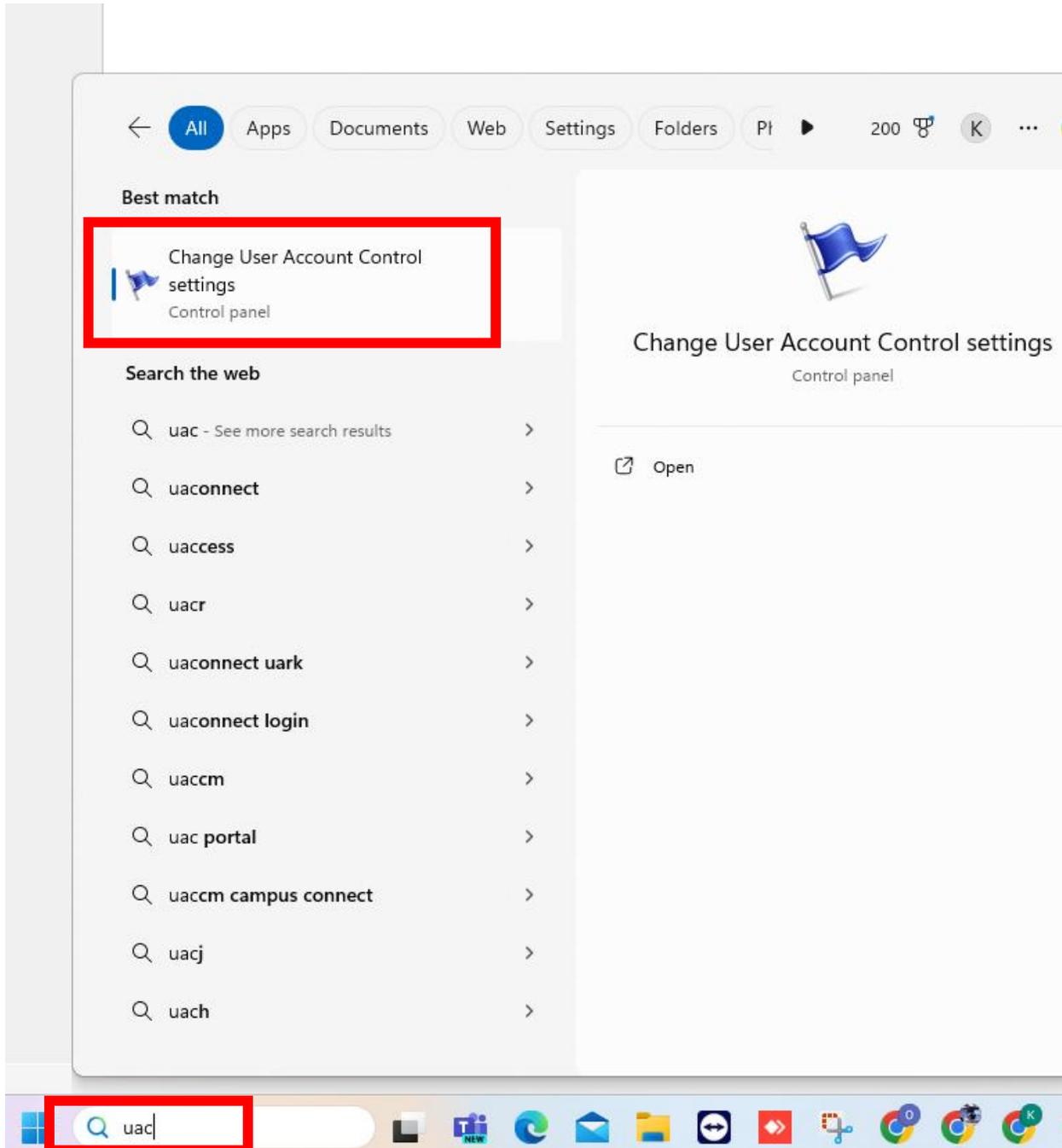
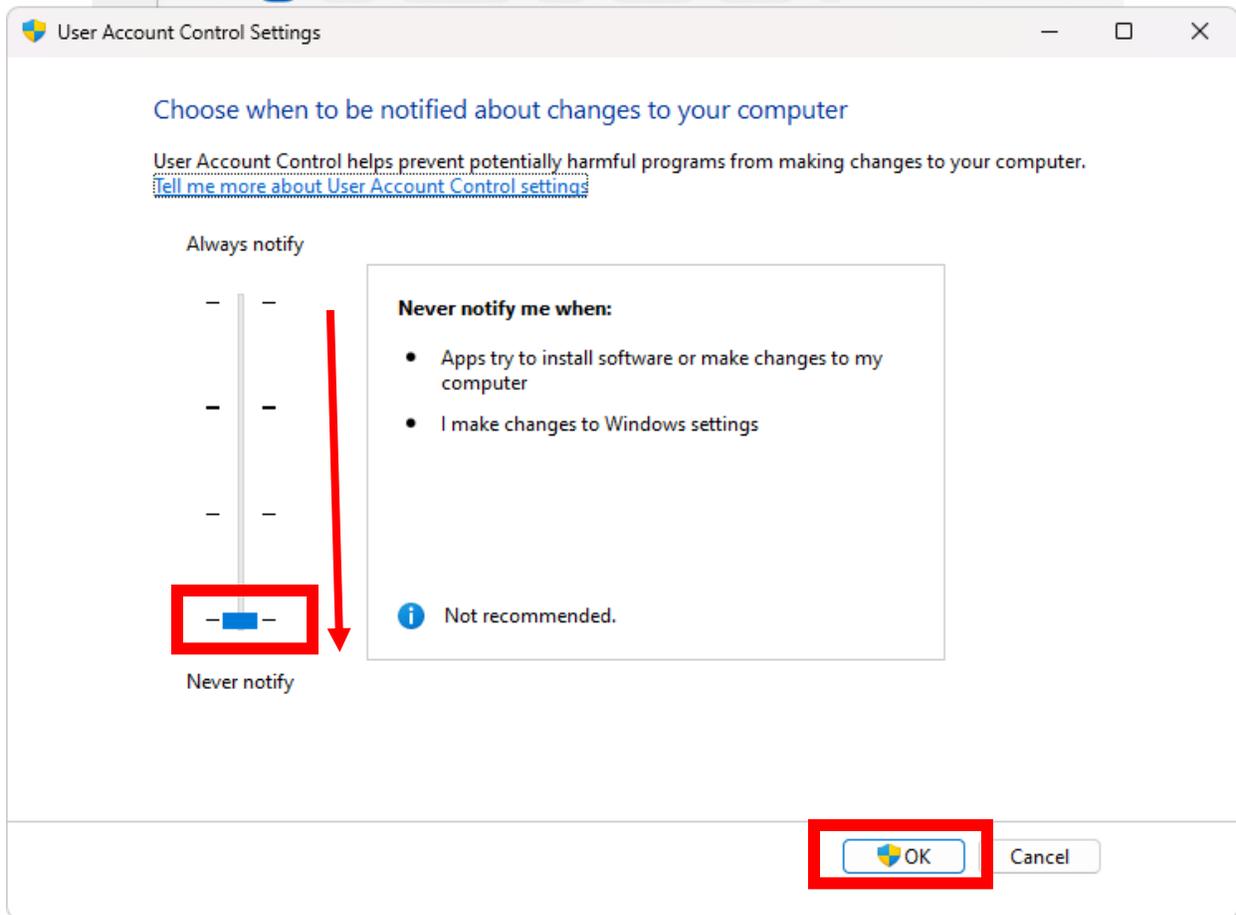


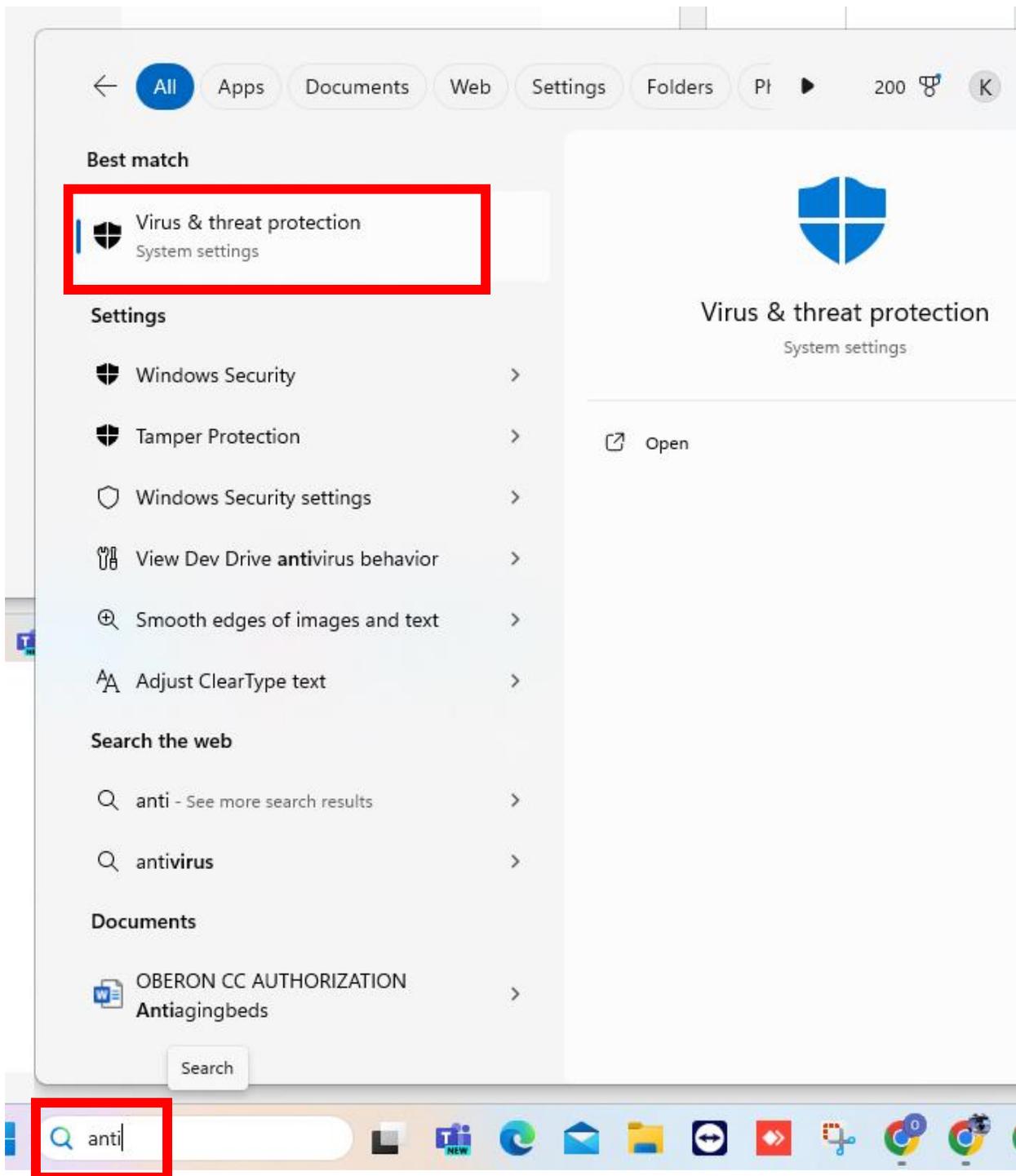
Turning off firewall and antivirus

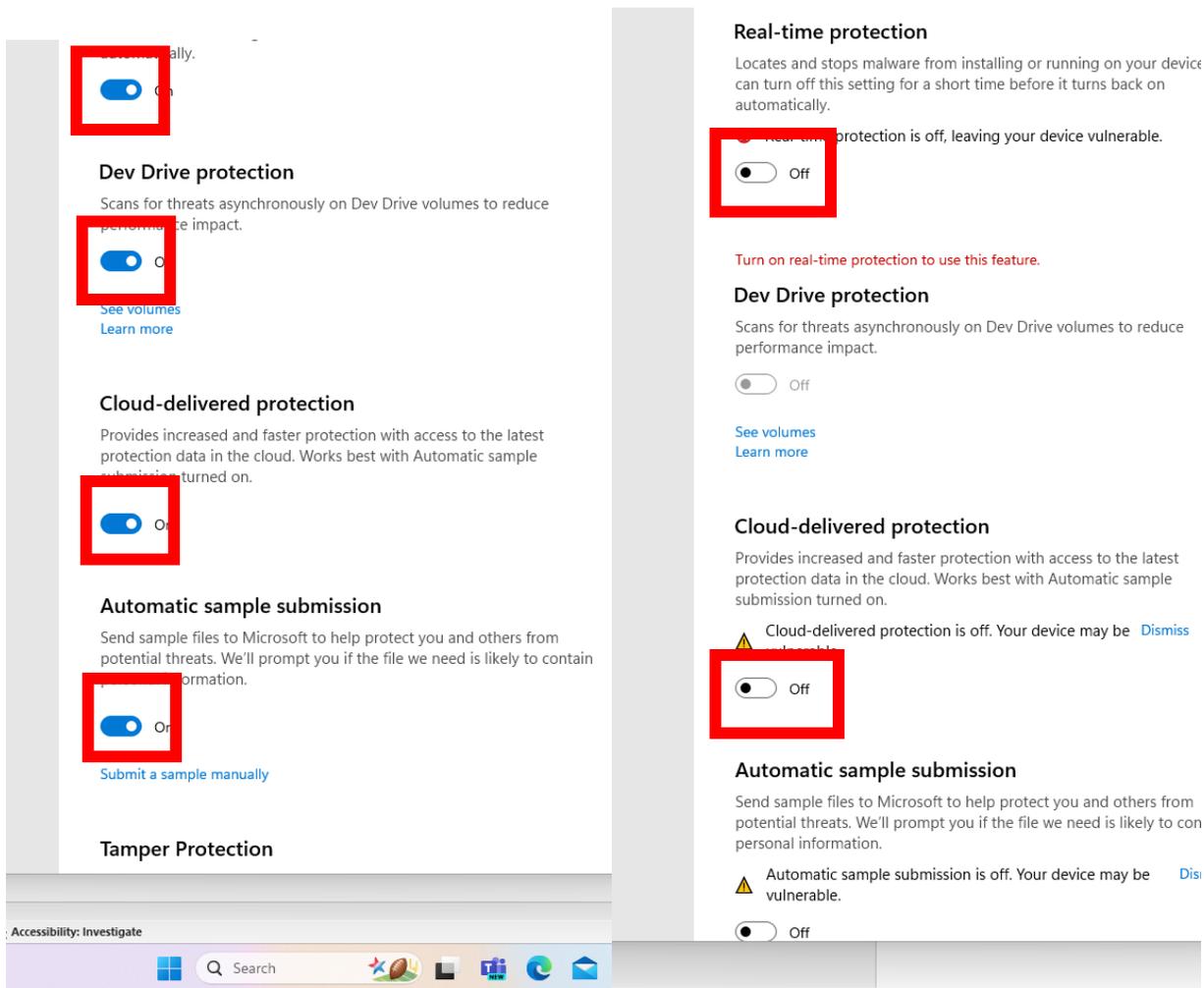

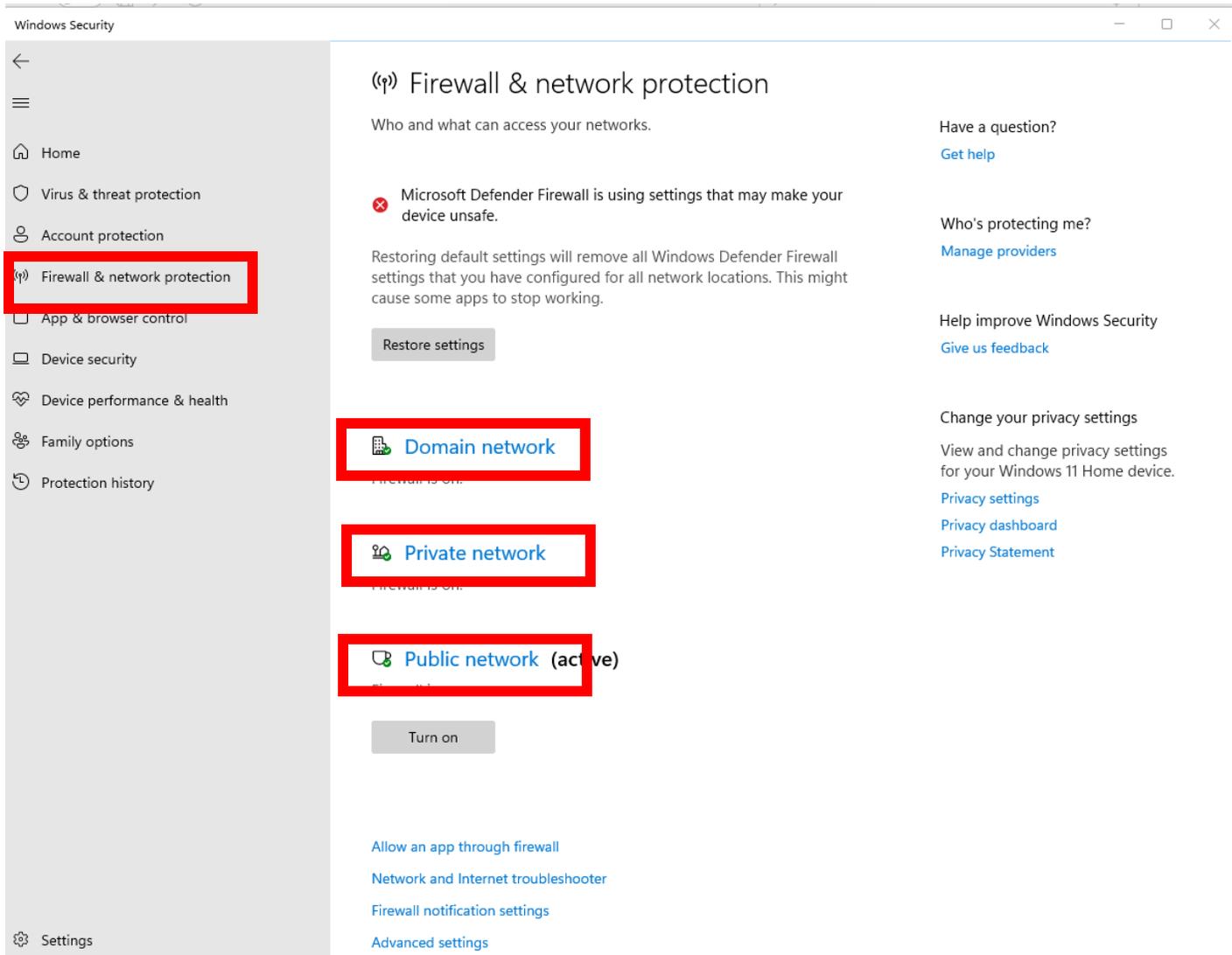

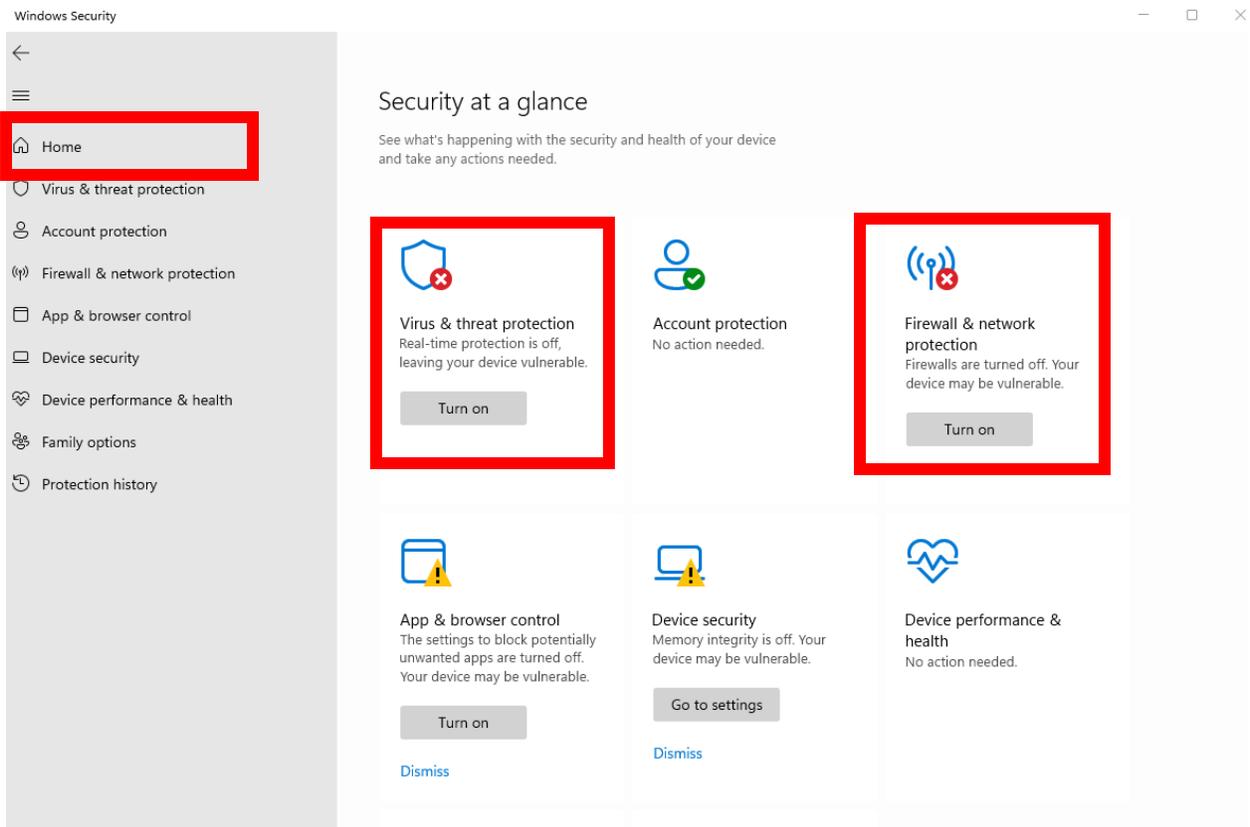
