

# Oberon Draw Count and Virtual Model Information Sheet



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## Disclaimer

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## 1. Draw Count = Duration / Number of Doses

- A higher draw count means the remedy remains “on board” longer, so it's used less frequently.
- Example from training:
  - **30,000 draw count** → RF remedy lasts ~12 hours/paraffin remedy applied every 10-12 hours
  - **6,000 draw count** → RF remedy last ~ 6 hours/paraffin 2–3 applications per day
  - **2,000 draw count** → RF remedy last ~ 6 hours/paraffin 2–3 applications per day for sensitive individuals or kids to avoid overstimulation
  - **300-500 draw count** → RF remedy last ~ 20-30 mins/paraffin 2–3 applications per day for new remedies to review reaction with client – recommend lower draw count (time remedy stays active in the body) for pets

## 2. Strength is Controlled Separately

- **Strength** is set by the **virtual model number (VMN)** (0–10), adjusted in the “ellipse” column.

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- You manually increase (or decrease if using auto model) this for remedies you want to increase the strength of the remedy (like antibacterial or anti-inflammatory agents).

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### Quick Recap Table

Parameter	What It Means	How It's Set
Strength	Potency of the remedy	Virtual model number (VMN) (0–10)
Draw Count	How long a dose stays active (dosing interval)	Selectable counts (e.g., 2k, 6k, 30k)
Frequency to Dose	How often client needs to reapply/take remedy	Depends on draw count

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### Example Usage:

- **Topical cream for infection**
  - Strength = 10 VMN (high impact remedies like antibacterial)
  - Draw count = 6,000 (duration of remedy per reprinter = about 6 hours)
  - **Sensitive client or child/pet**
    - Strength = 1–5 VMN (lower impact remedy)
    - Draw count = 2,000 (duration of remedy per reprinter = about 2 hours)
- **Testing the Remedy Response**
  - Strength 1-10 VMN (depending on the severity of symptoms)

- Draw count = 250 (duration of remedy per reprinter = about 15 minutes)

Additional scan thumb within the area of the body where discomfort is identified – although the VMN does not show need when using auto-model:

- **Muscles Front of Body/Back of Body** - Check entire organ first – if high virtual model, provide remedies through reprinter
- **Striated Muscle** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Nerve within the Striated Muscle** – (located under the venule thumb top center of the picture of the striated muscle)
- **Nerve (Yellow)** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Nerve Bundle** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Hyaline Cartilage** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Tendon** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Osseous Tissue** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Endothelia** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Mesothelium** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Epithelia** – (best results use thumb located within the area of the body that the client has discomfort)
- **Core Sections of the body** – Check entire organ first – if high virtual model, provide remedies through reprinter
  - **Shoulder Trunk** – Check entire organ first – if high virtual model, provide remedies through reprinter
  - **Pelvic** – Check entire organ first – if high virtual model, provide remedies through reprinter
  - **Organs of the Male Small Pelvis Left/Right** – Check entire organ first – if high virtual model provide remedies through reprinter
- **Hepatocyte/hepatic beam tissue** - Check entire organ first – if high virtual model, provide remedies through reprinter

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
